Pothole Repair

- Street Department Staff and contractors placed 24 tons of cold patch asphalt, repairing hundreds of potholes Townwide.
- Hot patch pothole repair was performed by a contract crew at:
 - Fountain Hills Blvd – Palisades Blvd to Glenbrook Blvd
 - Palisades Blvd – Saguaro Blvd to La Montana Dr



Saguaro Blvd Tree Planting

- 45 new trees were planted on Saguaro Blvd between Kingstree Blvd and Panorama Blvd

Non-Ferrous & Ferrous Metals Collection & Recycling

- Non-ferrous - These metals include aluminum, copper, nickel, lead, tin, and zinc
- Ferrous metals - Most common ferrous metals are steel, alloy steel, cast iron, and wrought iron

The Street Department collects and sells on average 2,500 lbs a month

The funds (\$500.00) is deposited into the Streets Fund for sign replacement

Visit the no-charge household hazardous waste (HHW) event for residents of Fountain Hills. **Please bring proper identification for proof of residency.**

✓ ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Aerosol cans
- Automotive fluids - motor oil, transmission fluid, antifreeze, brake fluid, windshield washer fluid
- Auto and light truck tires off the rim (residents are responsible for placement of tires into the roll-off dumpster)
- Batteries - lithium, NiCad, NiMH, lead-acid, alkaline
- Cooking oil
- Light bulbs - including compact fluorescent bulbs (CFLs), fluorescent tubes, LED bulbs and incandescent bulbs
- Fertilizer
- Gasoline, kerosene and diesel
- Hobby and photographic chemicals
- Household cleaners
- Mercury
- Outdated medication - does not include controlled substances
- Paint products - latex, oil-based, alkyd and bases, paint thinners (Limit 20 gal) No commercial use paint/ or contractors
- Pesticides, herbicides and weed killer
- Pool chemicals
- Road flares
- Water sealers
- Any other household product labeled CAUTION, WARNING, DANGER, POISON, TOXIC, FLAMMABLE, COMBUSTIBLE or CORROSIVE

✗ UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Ammunition, explosives and fireworks
- Appliances
- Commercial tires
- Commercial waste
- Documents for shredding
- Electronics
- Furniture
- Industrial waste
- Sharps or biomedical waste - blood, needles and bodily fluids
- Radioactive waste
- Research and university waste
